How to find available on-campus classes

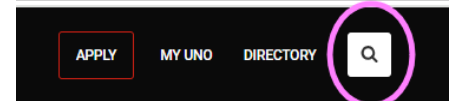
Begin with UNO's Class Search on the Website – Two Options

[Click on this Class Search Link](#)

OR

Navigate the UNO Website

- Start with a fresh browser (Google, FireFox, Safari etc.)
- Type “**unomaha.edu**” in the browser search area
- Click on the looking glass: top right corner of any UNO webpage.
- Type “**Class Search**” In the UNO Search Bar
- Choose the top response



Using the Class Search

Less is more – 3 Fields yield comprehensive results

- Choose a **Subject**
 - Click on the drop-down arrow for the list of options
 - Select a subject that interests you
- Click on **Show open courses only** toggle button to red
- **Instruction Method** – Choose “*In Person*” using the drop-down arrow
- Click on the red **Submit** at the bottom of the search for results
