- To share/submit individual projects that involve other CEC building partners and/or UNO campus partners
- Projects that may not be CEC related, but are of internal interest

# Examples of collaborative project/activity involving a UNO partner (e.g., faculty, staff, student, and/or organization):

- Collaborative grant proposal
- Collaborative outreach activity
- Community partner employee serves as board member
- Engaging UNO students as volunteers (non-credit)
- Faculty/staff research paid
- Faculty/staff support, non-research, paid
- Faculty/staff support, unpaid
- Faculty/staff/student serves as board member
- Guest lecturing for UNO class
- Internship, for credit (UNO Student)
- Offer scholarships
- Service learning class
- Shared resources/staff
- Student pipeline, mentorship, scholarships, after school-programming
- Technical assistance
- Training/Workshop
- UNO student research (e.g., capstone, thesis, dissertation, practicum, etc.)
- Other (this option will allow you to provide an answer if not listed above)

## What would we ask about a collaborative project/activity?

- The specific organizations/collaborators involved (e.g., UNO Support and Training for Evaluation of Programs (STEPs), UNO Department of Gerontology, etc.)
- A brief description/summary about the project (can include outcomes if known)
  - o Includes the option to upload any relevant attachments (e.g., publications/reports, papers, stories, fliers, data, etc.)
- Project data (e.g., total number of student volunteers)
