Taking the EPPE

You will have 90 minutes to complete this exam. Please use all of your time to craft a strong essay. Be sure to closely read your essay prompt so that you can accurately answer your selected question. Construct a thesis driven well-reasoned argument with ample support. Explore your ideas with depth and honesty. Craft sentences that are varied and well-constructed. Summarize the original author accurately and effectively integrate the author's points into your essay. Don't forget to proofread your essay before submitting it. Answer all questions.

1. Your [UNO NetID credentials](#) (Username and Password) is required to take English placement exam. This is not the 8-digit number. UNO NetID uses parts of your first and last name.
2. You must download and install a browser titled **Respondus Lock Down Browser** from this [web page](#).
For more information: [Respondus Lock Down Browser and Monitor Student Guide](#). This exam does not use the Respondus Monitor (web cam).
3. Open the **Respondus Lockdown Browser**.
4. A screen appears titled **Choose a Server**. Select the **UNO Canvas** option.
5. Log on with your **UNO NetID** and password.
6. On the Canvas Dashboard select the **"Year" English Placement Exam** course.
7. You will need to start with the Read Me First section and complete these steps before entering the exam.
8. Within the exam answer **ALL** of the questions.
9. A 90 minute running timer will appear top right side of screen.
10. **ONLY** click **Save** when you are finished. **(Clicking Save earlier will end your exam)**.
11. Click **Save** when finished.
12. Log off Canvas by closing the Lockdown Browser.
