### III. Officers' Reports

- A. President's Report: Senator Ostler

  - 2. Update on University Calendar proposal: As you know the NU System proposal for an updated calendar recommended an August 17th start date and an early release centered around the Thanksgiving holiday as a means to limiting students' exposure with holiday travel. UNO will continue with original calendar adding options that will allow instructors to continue remotely after Thanksgiving if needed. Some of these changes/options will use the holiday hours of Labor Day and Fall Break for instruction that will allow for early completion prior to the December holiday break where appropriate. With a number of Pandemic issues still unknown, discussions about Spring Calendar changes were put on hold but now appear to have resurfaced. One of the primary considerations at this point, for both Lincoln and Kearny campuses is the possibility of a January term (Jterm), which would push the spring semester to a late January to late May timeframe. Support for the J-term initiative seems to be substantial on all campuses except UNO, where we really have not heard the voice of faculty related to this issue because the idea is so new. With the expectation of a unified University calendar (to the extent possible), there may be considerable pressure to provide the same options as Lincoln and Kearny if they approve a J-term proposal on their respective campuses. With fall and spring calendar options in mind, Academic Affairs would likely seek input from faculty/units on two related

issues. The first would be the feasibility of a J-term running for approximately 3 weeks beginning just after the first of the year to the end of January. This would push back the spring semester to a completion point/commencement just prior to Memorial Day. The second would be recommendations for options about course offerings, particularly those providing experiential and Service Learning components, but also possibly broad offerings across the Gen Eds for remediation or pacing into advanced courses on a predictable timeline.

- 3. Budget: As you are all probably aware, President Carter announced significant cuts across the NU system. For UNO this is going to be approximately 4.2 million over three years. President Carter was, however, intentional about being committed to growth during this time.

Further Discussion: Senator Qureshi discussed faculty responses to the survey and, as a result of inconclusive results, a solid recommendation was not made. The data will be shared with Dr. Kopp. Faculty expressed a concern with pedagogy if a J term was in place. Senator Ostler reported that in discussing the academic calendar with other senate presidents in the state, they were at various stages of implementing a J term. Academic planning council members representing Faculty Senate should be named. It will be necessary to confirm elected chairs or elect chairs.

Further Discussion: Drew Nielson appreciates the partnership across the campus to develop, create, and approve these policies. An Ad Hoc committee is being sought from the Faculty Senate. The administration is seeking the input of the faculty about proposed calendar changes. The decision will need to be based upon the academic and intellectual pros of the change. President Ostler commented on his concern about multiple calendars in the NU system. Kearney and UNL would be on different schedules that UNO, which may be a challenge for students who attend both campuses. President Ostler made the senators aware of the changes from Box to Microsoft One Drive. This is as a result of a significant funding increase for Box.

Chancellor Gold discussed the economic impact of COVID on the University, mentioning the loss of state funding, enrollment uncertainty, increased expenses, and declines in other areas.
