



# FACULTY LEADERSHIP FORUMS



*Faculty Leadership Forums (FLFs) connect and promote networking among faculty across campus who occupy similar leadership roles or have related professional development interests.*

Faculty and group interests shape Faculty Leadership Forums, and concerns drive discussion topics.

## REQUIREMENTS OF A FLF

Faculty Leadership Forums must have a minimum of three members.

Submit a brief proposal to CFE by October 1<sup>st</sup> that includes:

- Focus of the group
- 2-3 specific issues to be addressed
- Anticipated meeting dates
- List of participants

Each FLF member must attend at least three meetings to be eligible for \$100 stipend.

Submit a brief summary report by April 1<sup>st</sup> with an overview of the group's accomplishments.

## WHY JOIN A FLF

Faculty Leadership Forums:

- **Connect** faculty members from multiple disciplines
- **Promote** professional development
- **Compile and Disseminate** existing knowledge to promote best practices
- **Support** collaborative processes to explore beneficial opportunities
- **Provide** development opportunities for new or potential leaders on campus
