## PLACEMENT EXAMS

These exams evaluate a student on their academic skill in a specific subject. Only students who have been officially admitted to the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) are eligible to take these exams.

- Math Placement Exam
- EPPE (English Placement Proficiency Exam)
- SPE (Spanish Placement Exam)
- FPE (French Placement Exam)

**NOTE:** A Math Practice Test as well as all Placement Exam scheduling information is available at **testing.unomaha.edu**.

## ACCOMMODATED EXAMS

The Accessibility Services Center (ASC) staff determines testing accommodations on a case-by-case basis for students with disabilities. Testing space is made available by the Testing Center, KH 522, and appointments are to be scheduled after accommodations are determined and discussed with the ASC. ## ONLINE DISTANCE EDUCATION (DE) EXAMS

Proctored for Faculty who have made arrangements for this service with the Testing Center. Students enrolled in a DE course that have exams to be taken at the Testing Center will need to schedule their testing appointments on MavLINK by going to **mavlink.unomaha.edu**.

## CREDIT BY EXAMINATION

Allows students the opportunity to gain academic credit for knowledge acquired by self-study or experience.
