Requirements for a Susan T. Buffett Foundation College Scholarship

Graduating high school seniors or incoming freshmen are eligible to receive a Susan T. Buffett Foundation Scholarship and join UNO's Thompson Learning Community.

The primary criterion is financial need (FAFSA required), but applicants must also meet all criteria below:

- Nebraska resident
- Attendance or application to a Nebraska state public college or university or a two-year public college in Nebraska
- 2.5 GPA throughout high school

Scholarship details

At UNO, the scholarship provides up to \$4500 per semester for tuition, fees and books. It also covers up to 5 years at UNO or until graduation, whichever comes first.
