

PHI DELTA GAMMA SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of the Phi Delta Gamma scholarships shall be to encourage and assist men and women of promising talent and ability to complete the requirements for a Graduate Degree at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. A scholarship of \$700.00 (to be awarded \$350 per semester in which requirements are fulfilled) may be awarded during an academic year to a student who has been accepted into a graduate program and has ***completed nine (9) graduate hours within their degree program at the time of application. The applicant shall register for and successfully complete six or more graduate hours in each semester of the academic year in which the award is granted. The minimum requirement of six or more graduate hours may be waived in the semester in which the student is to graduate.***

Each Phi Delta Gamma Scholarship shall be awarded as follows:

- a. The Office of Graduate Studies at the University of Nebraska at Omaha shall announce and receive applications for a Phi Delta Gamma Scholarship.
- b. Each scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of ability and the promise of success. Ability shall be evaluated in terms of excellence in academic scholarship, character, leadership, and personality.
- c. The Dean for Graduate Studies shall review credentials of all applicants and from the best qualified, in his or her judgment, select the scholarship winners.
- d. The scholarship is not renewable, but a recipient may apply each year in which they are eligible.
