Intensive

Intensive Language at UNO (ILUNO) students are in class up to 21 hours a week. Students participate in frequently planned social activities to practice their English and make new friends. Sessions last two (2) months and are scheduled six (6) times throughout the year.

Experienced

The University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) has offered English as a Second Language to international students for more than 40 years. Experienced instructors teach reading and vocabulary, grammar and writing, speaking and listening, pronunciation, TOEFL or IELTS preparation, and critical-thinking skills.

Online Classes

It is now possible to study in ILUNO from your home country! Studying from your home can cost much less than travel and living expenses in the U.S. You can take one (1) class or several classes at once and strengthen your English skills at your own pace.

Hybrid Classes

Many of our students want to come to Omaha and experience life in the U.S. ILUNO is offering a hybrid program with both in-person and online classes. Students can come to class 1-2 days each week and study from home the other days of the week. This flexible program lets students choose how they want to learn and allows students outside of Omaha to study from their home.

Student Services

Students receive personalized assistance with airport pickup service, housing, orientation, immigration, and health issues.

Wellness Center

Features fitness equipment, pool, a rock-wall, indoor courts for various sports, the Nebraska Medicine UNO Health Center, and more.

Criss Library

At the library you can borrow books, movies, laptops, media equipment, and more. The library also has computer labs, study spaces, printing stations, a creative production lab, and other services students may access.

Milo Bail Student Center
