4. On the right side of the screen, look for the **View** options. Click on **Grades**.

6. You will see your grades. For sessions that are finished, grades will appear in the column with the red arrow. These are only **final grades**, so you will not see grades until the class is over. If there are classes without grades, these are the classes you are currently taking.

American Grading: Letter and Number Grades

Academic grading in the United States commonly takes on the form of five letter grades. The grades are A, B, C, D and F — A being the highest and F being the lowest. Sometimes these grades have a + or – with them to show if you are at the high end of the letter or the low end. This is determined by the number grade that matches the letter grade. For example, a score of 90% is usually an A- and a score of 98% is an A+. The picture below shows the letter grades and number grades that go together.

Letter Grade	Percentage
A	90-100
B	80-89
C	70-79
D	60-69
F	0-59

For ILUNO, grades of A+, A, A-, B+, B, and B- are passing grades for core classes (Reading, Writing, & Grammar and Listening & Speaking). If you receive a score of C+ or lower, you will need to retake the class.

Grade Point Average (GPA)

A grade point average (GPA) is a calculated average of the letter grades you earn in school following a 0 to 4.0 scale. Every semester, you'll receive a GPA based on the grades you earned in all of your classes during that semester. Throughout your studies, you'll also have a cumulative GPA, which is an ongoing average of all your grades.
