Each apartment has four bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and a dining/living area. Four students share each apartment.

The apartments are furnished with beds, desks, desk chairs, nightstands, dresser, couch, chair, end tables, coffee tables, and dining table and chairs. The kitchens include a stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, and microwave,. Most apartments have wall-to-wall carpeting in the bedroom and living areas. All apartments have wireless internet. Other conveniences for students living on campus include a clubhouse with big screen TV, study/computer rooms, on-site laundry facilities, planned events and activities, and on-site management staff.

You will need to bring or buy the following items as they are not provided:

Bed linens (pillows, sheets, pillowcases, and blankets) Bath linens (towels, washcloths)

Living in an American home while studying English can provide a good opportunity for you to learn about American culture, to improve your listening and speaking skills, and to get to know Americans.

<u>Who will be my host</u>? Many hosts are married couples or single people whose children have left home. Some homestays are like roommate situations. The International Student Advisors, who visit each home before placing a student there, screen all of our hosts.

What will my host expect of me? You will need to be flexible and cooperative. Hosts expect to share their homes with mature, independent, college-aged students. Living in a homestay means that you will enter into the host family's lifestyle, and you will probably need to make some adjustments.

What will my host provide? Living and meal arrangements vary. All students will have private rooms but will have to share the shower/bath facilities, kitchen, and laundry. If meals are not provided, your hosts will take you to the grocery store with them so that you can prepare your own meals.
