Eligibility

Any UNO faculty, staff, or students.

How to Submit a Photograph

- 1. Each individual may submit up to 3 photos of either 4" x 6" or 8" x 10". Photos can include things like scenery, buildings, locations, people, and group pictures.
- 2. Pictures taken in the U.S. will <u>NOT</u> be allowed.
- 3. Entries must be emailed to <u>unophotocontest@gmail.com</u> along with the attached entry form.
- 4. For each photograph, you must include:

Title of Photograph Your Name Location (City, Region and/or Country) Month and Year Taken

- 5. Pick up an entry form in ASH 241 or download at world.unomaha.edu/iew
- 6. Along with your photos you may submit a comment of up to 125 words. This can be about the description of the photo, your feelings about being abroad, or any experiences you had.
- 7. UNO and International Studies & Programs retain the following rights:
 - the right to edit any comments for length and/or suitability.
 - the right to use any of the submitted photographs for University publications, acknowledging the owner but not financially compensating the owner for its use.
 - The applicant grants UNO non-exclusive license to reproduce and publish the photos for University-related non-profit publications.

Date and Location of Contest and Exhibit

Photos will be displayed in the Criss Library from Friday, November 15 - Friday, November 22, 2019.

Deadline for Submissions

All photographs must be submitted electronically to <u>unophotocontest@gmail.com</u> by *November 12, 2019.* Photographs will not be accepted after Wednesday, November 12 at 3:00pm.

Voting for Best Photos

All students, faculty and staff members of UNO will be able to vote in person at the Criss Library International Photo Contest exhibit. The voting deadline is *Wednesday, November 20 at 3:00pm*.

Announcement of Contest Winners

Winners of the Photo Contest will be announced during International Education Week November 18 to 22, 2019. The announcement will be made on *Thursday, November 21* at 3:00pm during Cafe Internationale in the International Studies & Programs Office (ASH 241). Prizes will be awarded at that time. Winners do not need to be present to collect prizes.
