RECOMMENDATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

	Not Vaccinated	Fully Vaccinated
Mandatory test required before flying to US within 72 hours	✓	✓
Get tested 3-5 days after arrival in Nebraska	✓	✓
Self-quarantine after travel for 7 days with a negative test	✓	
Self-monitor for symptoms using the 1-Check app	✓	✓
Wear a mask and take other precautions	✓	✓

## TESTING & VACCINATION



You will need to schedule a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after travel, regardless of vaccine status. Please contact the UNO Office of Health Security with your test results.

Interested in getting the vaccine? You can schedule an appointment by visiting the Douglas County Health Department's website. Keep in mind, your appointment date must be after your quarantine period ends.
