Study abroad down under! Spend six weeks in Sydney, Australia through a partnership between the University of Nebraska at Omaha and the University of Sydney. You will study alongside other UNO students on this unique, experiential learning program for UNO credit. The UNO course that you will take is PE3900, Motivation for Physical Activity. When taught in Sydney the class takes the approach of looking at the environmental influence on physical activity behaviors.

For example, how does the community environment (walkability, park/playground accessibility and quality, population density, public transportation opportunity, etc) influence the choices people make regarding daily physical activity behaviors? Furthermore, we will take a comparative approach by recognizing the similarities and differences between the community environment in Sydney versus that in Omaha.
