

Professional Question Examples

It can be challenging to come up with useful questions to ask a professional when having these conversations. Below are some examples of questions you may want to ask.

- Could you tell me about your educational background?
 - Did you complete an certifications, certificates, or programs outside of your degree?
 - o Is an advanced degree needed to advance in this field/company?
- What advice can you give a recent graduate looking to break into the field?
- What does an average day look like for your position?
 - What are some special or unique projects you have been able to work on?
- What sort of professional development opportunities does your company offer?
- What do you enjoy most about your field and/or company?
- Can you recommend any activities or organizations I should join to gain further experience in this career path?
 - What about listservs, FB groups, etc.?
- What unique skills or abilities are highly sought after in this field?
 - o What would be the best experiences, skills, etc. to highlight on my resume?
- What is one important thing I should know before deciding to work in/for X?
- Do you know of any employment opportunities available at your company (or in the field)?



 Do not ask this right away as the point of this conversation is to asking probing questions about the field/company. Once you have asked some of these questions and have found that this career path would be a good fit, you can inquire about job opportunities.
