### PAPER PRODUCTS



**56% less** paper towel use compared to last year, largely due to switching to battery-powered dispensers. Each roll is made up of 100% recovered fibers, containing up to 78% in post-consumer waste. Meets EPA standards; FSC® and EcoLogo® certified

**6%** of copy/printer paper used this year had recycled content

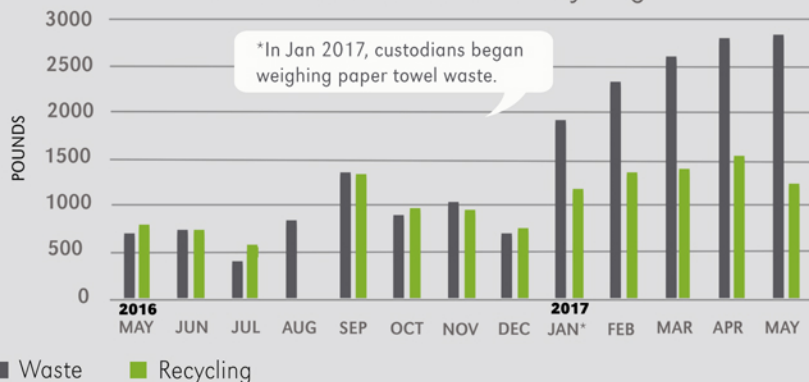
**1,354**

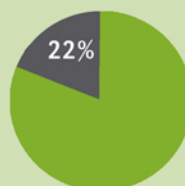
### CLOTHING SWAP

**300 lbs**

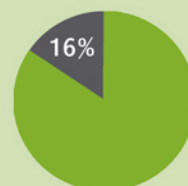
300 pounds of clothing was donated for students, faculty or staff to take freely. Items not taken were given to shelters.

### WASTE SORT

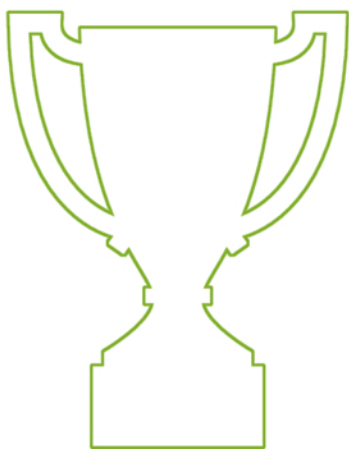
Waste sort showed a 3% increase in accuracy compared to last year.
