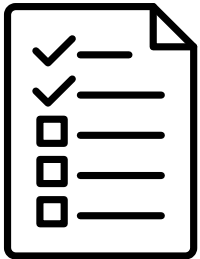


# WANT TO KNOW HOW TO VOTE?

## 1. REGISTER

**In Nebraska, the last day to register is October 26 at 6 P.M.**

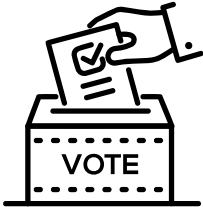
**In order to register to vote you must be:**

- 18 years of age or older;
- U.S. citizen; and
- Never been convicted of a felony.

1. The Election Commissioner's Office.
2. The Department of Motor Vehicles.
3. Voting drives throughout the community.

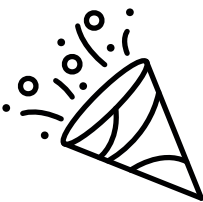
