Graduate Lecturer



The criteria for a Graduate Lecturer as approved by the Graduate Faculty is as follows:

- 1. Have completed **at least two years of full-time work experience relevant to the discipline to be taught**, this may include teaching, research, professional experience, or any combination.
- 2. Hold the terminal degree normally accepted for academic employment in the discipline or have achieved some extraordinary accomplishment as determined by the Graduate committee of the nominee's department or inter> departmentarea." (Graduate Faculty Minutes, February 21, 1974, Motion 282). The appropriate terminal degrees and the extraordinary accomplishment are contained the Graduate Faculty Credential Form adopted by the program and on file in the Office of Graduate Studies and Office of Academic Affairs.
- **<u>NOTE</u>**: Graduate Lecturers are <u>not</u> Members of the Graduate Faculty—all Members are appointed by the Board of Regents whereas Graduate Lecturer designations are only special permission to teach specific courses for graduate credit for a period up to (4) years, with option for renewal

Note: Graduate Lecturer status must be approved prior to a final letter of offer for the first time teaching a course.
