FELIPE BLANCO

Growing up, Felipe Blanco did not know what path he would follow. With two parents who taught and worked in higher education at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (NAUM) in his home of Mexico City, Mexico, he had an inkling that some form of education would be part of the picture.

Blanco, now a highly recognized doctoral student in Public Administration, graduated in UNO's May 2023 commencement. Blanco's work with UNO has been widely published and celebrated for its novel, unique look at issues around equity, identity, and representation.

Blanco received his Master of Public Administration & Master of Public Policy from Centro de Investigación y Docencia Económicas (CIDE), in which his focus at the time was more about evaluating the relationship between democracy and public policy. He worked as a consultant for public organizations and adjunct professor at CIDE in Mexico.

EDUCATIONAL SPECIALIST (Ed.S.) DEGREE

The educational specialist (Ed.S.) degree options at UNO are intended to further a PK-12 educator’s expertise beyond the master’s degree. The Ed.S. is a post-master’s program in which candidates attain a broad and systematic understanding of professional education, knowledge of a particular field of specialization, and an ability to apply theoretical concepts of education in an actual educational context. Ed.S. program options include: 1) Educational Administration & Supervision; or 2) School Psychology.

DOCTORAL DEGREE

A doctoral degree is the pinnacle of graduate education, attracting the best and the brightest domestic and international students. A doctoral recipient is in an elite category, with less than two percent of the U.S. population earning a Ph.D. Students who relish intellectual challenges and have a thirst for knowledge through research will enjoy and thrive in doctoral study.

RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITY

An essential part of every graduate program is for students to learn to use the tools of research, both scholarly and applied. The Office of Research and Creative Activity (ORCA) provides leadership in the development of that research by securing grants and other funding opportunities, as well as partnerships with expert faculty mentors to help advance knowledge. There are \$5,000 grants available for students to support faculty-mentored research or creative activity. In addition, through the Office of Graduate Studies, students can receive \$500 to support travel to present at professional conferences.

Graduate students from all disciplines can showcase their research and creative activity in the form of oral presentations, performances, exhibits, and posters at the annual Research and Creative Activity Fair.

UNO's premier graduate school education is offered at the most affordable tuition rates in the region and provides a multitude of funding sources for graduate students to help afford their education.

FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the U.S. Department of Education to discover the types of aid that you qualify for. Students of all income levels may qualify for federal student loans, so we encourage any student who believes they will need assistance to apply.

FAFSA applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Have a valid social security number
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent (or will have one by the year you are receiving aid)
- Must be enrolled/planning to enroll in a degree seeking program
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Not owe a refund on a federal student grant or be in default on a federal student loan

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

Graduate Assistants (GAs) fulfill many roles on campus, from teaching undergraduate students to assisting faculty with research and presentations. These assistantships reward students who excel in their academic performance at the graduate level and show potential within their field of study.

GAs work 20 hours a week and carry a minimum of six graduate credit hours each semester. In addition to tuition remission, GAs receive a monthly salary and are eligible for subsidized health insurance.

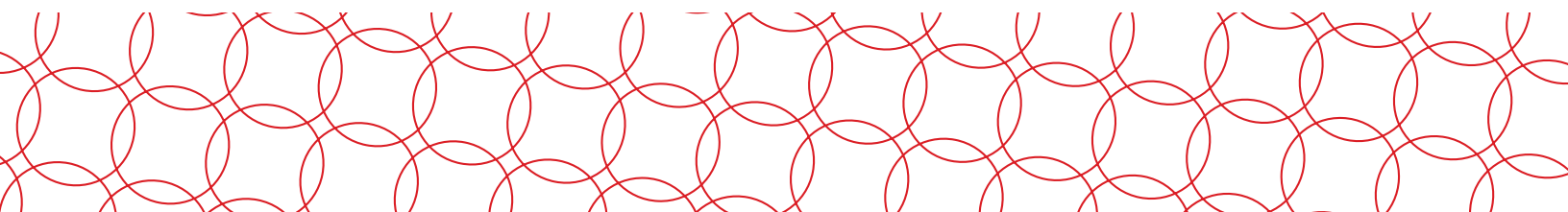

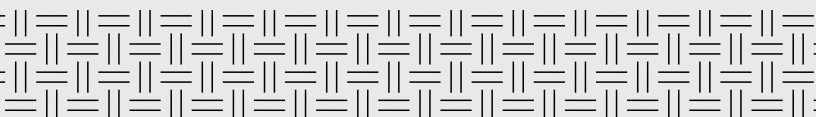

MANDATORY FEES

WRITING CENTER

The UNO Writing Center offers free one-on-ones for writers on any subject at any stage of the writing process. The writing center staff will discuss your writing, provide feedback, and coach you through the stages of writing your paper—from brainstorming to the finishing touches. Consultations last 30 or 60 minutes and can be done in-person or online. UNO Writing Center staff consists of undergraduate consultants, graduate teaching assistants, post graduate consultants, volunteers, and interns. The Office of Graduate Studies and the University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) fund a limited number of graduate consultants on our staff. These consultants have more experience consulting with master's and doctoral level writing projects and are identified by an "*" next to their names in the online schedule.

ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES CENTER

The Accessibility Services Center (ASC) collaborates with students, administrators, faculty, and staff to ensure that we provide reasonable and appropriate accommodations and equal access to university programming for our students with disabilities.

COUNSELING AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES (CAPS)

CAPS provides services that can help with the challenges impacting your overall well-being. These could include adjusting to life events, relationship issues, and mental health symptoms. Counseling services are confidential and conducted by Licensed Mental Health Practitioners and graduate interns.

DURANGO'S ADVANCEMENT AND SUPPORT HUB (DASH)

DASH is designed to welcome and engage students, build and foster community collaborations, and create opportunities for professional development and social mobility. They offer Hardship & Resiliency Support for those facing unique challenges as they navigate college, the Peer Mentor Alliance, which is a community of students dedicated to building collaboration and community, and the Scholarship Collective, a portfolio of scholarships tailored to various talents, backgrounds, and aspirations.

MILITARY-CONNECTED RESOURCE CENTER

Military-Connected Resource Center (MCRC) fosters and encourages UNO's military community—on-campus, online, and overseas. It focuses on academic achievement, career attainment, financial health, and overall physical and mental wellness.
