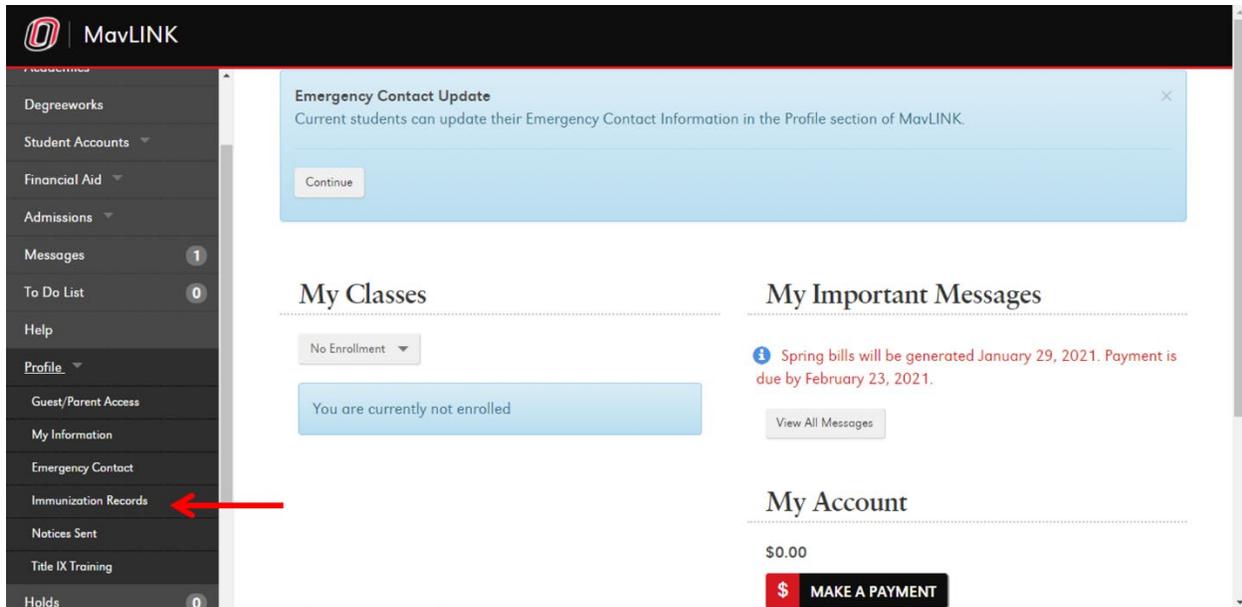


How to access vaccine history via MavLINK

1. Log in to MavLINK
2. From the left-hand menu, select 'Profile' and then 'Immunization Records'



3. Select 'Generate Immunization Record'

- All new international students are required to have a test for tuberculosis done at the UNO Health Center when they arrive on campus.
- An appointment is required to be seen. Appointments can be scheduled by calling 402.554.2374. Clinic hours are Monday - Friday, 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM.

Information on Meningococcal Meningitis Disease for all students:

- Nebraska state law requires post-secondary institutions to provide students and parent's information related to meningococcal meningitis disease, especially those that are living in UNO housing.

UNO Immunization Record

UNO students can print their official UNO Immunization Record at any time after the immunizations have been verified by UNO staff by clicking on the Generate Immunization Record button.

Also, students can view and print out a copy of their immunization record that was uploaded to your MavLINK account by going to the Immunization Portal button and selecting View/Attach record.
