



☐ **Submit Animal Exposure Health Surveillance Questionnaire**

1. RSS→EHS tab→ Med Questionnaire→UNO
2. Category 1 is for entrance into the animal facility, field work, and contact with vivarium animals (rodents, fish, lizards, dogs).
3. Category 2 is for contact with nonhuman primates. DO NOT COMPLETE THIS QUESTIONNAIRE IF YOU WILL NOT BE WORKING WITH NHPs. Com

☐ **Complete Occupational Health and Safety Training**

1. Email iacuc@unomaha.edu for enrollment in the course, and include the following information:
 - a. Species you will be working with
 - b. PI/Faculty you are working with
 - c. If you are providing husbandry and/or will be doing research
2. Once you receive the enrollment link, log in to Bridge and complete training with grade of 80% or above
