

## **How to Find Related Links on Webpages**

If you need to remove a document (like an old PDF) or an old webpage from the website, you will first need to find other pages on which the file or page is linked to ensure there are no broken links on the site.


- Ensure you're on the document or page you want to verify is linked from another page.
- Go to the toolbar and click ...More>>click Relationships




• A new window will appear if the document or page is linked on other pages. Click the page link on the left under "Asset":



 You will be taken to the page and will need to scan the page to find the link. Make sure to look at the sidebar under "Related Links" or "Additional Resources."





- Delete the hyperlinked text if necessary, or modify the content as needed.
- Click the back arrow on your browser window to go back to the page listing.
- Remove links on all remaining pages.
- Once the links have been removed, go to the document (or page) you are unlinking and go to ...More>>Unpublish then ...More>>Delete
